Sub: Representation in Reply to the Final Show Cause Notice.

Respected Sir,

This is to bring to your kind notice that the aforesaid Notice (Final Show Cause Notice dated 27th January 2020) has been received by the College of Teacher Education (PGT), Shillong, Section 17(1) of NCTE Act, 1993 and that, the College is required to submit the individual representation/affidavit of Rs. 100 on Non Judicial Stamp paper within a period of 21 days i.e. on or before 16.02.2020.

Further I would like to state that the College, established in 1964 has been singlehandedly spearheading in the field of teacher education with special reference to training and clearing the backlog of untrained teachers at the Secondary level in the State up to, when other Teacher Education Institutions were set up in the State. It may also be stated that, despite serious constraints of finance, manpower and infrastructure, the College has over

the years significantly contributed towards teacher preparation and development through pre-service and in-service training programmes.

In the following paragraphs a reply to the observations of the Eastern Regional Committee, NCTE, are hereby presented with relevant enclosures (Annexures):

Observation (i): Faculty list is not signed by the competent authority by the affiliating body. Faculty comprises 1+7 instead of 1+15 as per NCTE Regulation 2014.

Respectfully, it may be stated that as has always been a practice adopted in the past with respect to UGC related matters and the State Government, the list of the teaching faculty was always duly signed by the Director, College Development Council, North Eastern Hill University, Shillong. However, the observation by the Eastern Regional Committee, NCTE in its meeting held on 16th – 18th January 2020 at Bhubaneshwar, Odisha clearly indicates that the Director of College Development Council, North Eastern Hill University is not the designated competent authority. In this regard the College expressed regret. In view of the observation made the College had the list of faculty duly signed by the Registrar, North Eastern Hill University, Shillong. (Annexure I)

That, the NCTE observes that in light of the terms of Section 14(3) n (a) of NCTE Act and in accordance with the Regulation of 2014, recognition was granted to the College of Teacher Education for conducting B.Ed. programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 50 for one basic unit from the academic session 2015 – 2016. (Annexure II)

Further, it may be reiterated that the College has only one basic unit of 50 students, with students' strength being 100 (odd and even Semester). Vide No 1 of Clause 5 .1 (i) of NCTE Regulation 2014 stating that, "if the students strength for two years is one hundred (with one basic unit) only, the number of faculty shall be reduced to 8". it may therefore be pointed out that in light of the aforesaid note, the College humbly submits that the NCTE Regulation 2014 may be noted to have been clearly complied to. (Annexure III)

Observation (ii): Original Building Plan (BP) duly signed by the competent authority to be submitted.

&

Observation (iii): and Building Completion Certificate (BCC) duly signed by the competent authority to be submitted.

The College set up in 1964 in the then composite state of Assam functioned from Jail Road Boys, Shillong as it did not have its own building and that the shared office room between Jail Road Boys School and the then Post Graduate Training College, resulted in

putting into disarray, displacement and even loss of vital college records and documents. Moreover, during the subsequent years, it may be stated that the Original Building Plan and the Building Completion Certificate (BCC) was reportedly never required to be submitted to any competent authority, whatsoever, it may be at different points in time, even till shifting of the College to its present Campus.

Regretfully, an attention may be drawn to the fact that the Original Building Plan and the Building Completion Certificate (BCC) and other related documents are not found/available among the records and, that, the same came to light until the College was directed to submit the Original Building Plan by the esteemed Eastern Regional Committee, NCTE. (Annexure IV)

Moreover, as mentioned earlier, the College, at the time of its establishment was during the time when Shillong was in the then composite State of Assam and that, it is extremely difficult to identify the competent authority of that time, especially when it is 50 years ago. However, some kind of effort was initiated to locate the documents from the competent authority of the Government of Assam but in view of the age of the documents, nothing was forthcoming,

Observation (iv): Certified copy of Fire Safety Certificate duly signed by the Government competent authority to be submitted.

With regard to the issue of Fire Safety Certificate, the College had written to the Superintendent of Police (Fire and Emergency Services) Meghalaya, Shillong on 5th December 2019 to issue the Certificate. It may be reported that on the same day, the Office issued a **Provisional No Objection Certificate Cum Suggestion**, (with 8 suggestions) to the College valid for a period of three months. The process of installation started after all necessary logistical considerations were approved, and that, on completion of installation the Fire Safety Certificate was issued on 4th February 2020. (Annexure V)

Observation (v): Requisite information of the institutional website has not been updated as per clause 7 (14) (i) of NCTE Regulation 2014.

On Observation No. 5, the College expressed its deepest regret for its lackadaisical attitude towards the institutional website and that, the institution submits that, in a digitalization age, the website is a digital window to the world. However, with a deep sense of remorse, the College humbly submits that it has failed to initiate efforts in making the institutional website more informative as envisaged by NCTE through its format and to bring in more dynamism and vibrancy to the website.

The College sincerely makes a submission that in view of the observation, necessary interventions are already initiated to update the website at the earliest in accordance with NCTE format in right earnest and intent.

Conclusion:

I deeply express my gratitude to you for providing this opportunity to hear us out through this reply. In light of the above stated facts, I humbly submit my plea to consider the facts which are true to the best of my knowledge, belief and information. I pray before you to kindly reserve drastic action against the College for non-compliance of Section 14(3) n (a) of NCTE Regulation and that, the College is granted permission to continue to operate as a leading Teacher Education Institution (TEI) in the State.





WHEREAS, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of Section 32 of the National Council for Teacher Education Act, 1993 (73 of 1993), and in supersession of the National Council for Teacher Education [Recognition Norms and Procedure] Regulations, 2009, the National Council for teacher Education has notified the Regulations, 2014 on 01.12.2014.

2. **AND WHEREAS** the institution viz. **College of Teacher Education (PGT), Boyce Road Laitumkhrah, East Khasi Hills, Shillong, Meghalaya-793003** was granted recognition for conduct of **B.Ed.** course of **one** year duration with an annual intake of **100** from the academic session **2003-2004** vide ERC order no. **ERC/7-29/2002/4014, Dt. 12.11.2002.**

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution viz. College of Teacher Education (PGT), Boyce Road Laitumkhrah, East Khasi Hills, Shillong, Meghalaya-793003 has by affidavit dated **22.01.2015** consented to come under New Regulations 2014 and sought for **one basic unit in B.Ed. course.**

4. **AND WHEREAS**, it has been decided to permit the institution to have one basic unit of 50 students.

- I. The Endowment fund of Rs. 5 lakhs and Reserve fund of Rs. 7 lakhs kept in joint account with Regional Director of NCTE should be maintained perpetually. Loan raising against or mortgaging of FDR's shall not be done.
- II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
- III. The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations 2014.
- IV. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.

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5. **Now therefore**, in the light of the above and in terms of Section 14(3) (a) of NCTE Act and in accordance with the Regulations, 2014, the Eastern Regional Committee, NCTE hereby grants recognition to **College of Teacher Education (PGT), Boyce Road Laitumkhrah, East Khasi Hills, Shillong, Meghalaya-793003** for conducting **B.Ed.** Programme of **two** years duration with an annual intake of 50 for one basic unit of 50 student from the academic session **2015-2016**.

6. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfilment of other requirements as may be prescribed by NCTE from time to time and other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/ Body, the State Government etc. as applicable.

7. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

8. The institutions shall maintain & update its web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure:-

- a) Sanctioned programmes along with annual intake in the institution;
- b) Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph.
- c) Name of faculty members who left or joined during the last, quarter;
- d) Names of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.;
- e) Fee charged from students;
- f) Available infrastructural facilities;
- g) Facilities added during the last quarter;
- h) Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter;
- i) The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.
- j) The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information. If it so desires.
- k) Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.

4.3 Assessment

For Perspectives in Education and Curriculum and Pedagogic Studies, at least 20% to 30% marks may be assigned for continuous internal assessment and 70% to 80% marks for external examination. One-fourth of the total marks/weightage shall be allocated to assessment of practice teaching. The weightage for internal and external assessment shall be prescribed by the affiliating university. Candidates must be internally assessed on the entire course of Engagement with the Field and not only on the project/field work given to them as part of their units of study. The basis for assessment and criteria used ought to be transparent for students to benefit maximally out of professional feedback. Students shall be given information about their grades/marks as part of professional feedback so that they get the opportunity to improve their performance. The bases of internal assessment may include individual or group assignments, observation records, student portfolio, diaries, journal etc.

5. Staff

5.1 Academic Faculty

For an intake of two basic units of 50 students each, that is total students strength of 200, there shall 16 full-time faculty members.

The distribution of faculty across different curricular areas shall be as under:

1. Principal/ HoD	One
2. Perspectives in Education	Four
3. Pedagogy subjects (Maths, Science, Social Science, Language)	Eight
4. Health and Physical Education	One
5. Fine Arts	One
6. Performing Arts (Music/Dance/Theatre)	One

Note: (i) The faculty positions listed under different subject categories may teach course(s) in the Teacher Education Programme across curricular areas specified, and can cater to both foundation and pedagogy course(s). If the students' strength for two years is one hundred (with one basic unit) only, the number of faculty shall be reduced to 8.


(ii) Faculty can be utilised for teaching in flexible manner so as to optimize academic expertise available.

5.2 Qualifications

The faculty shall possess the following qualifications:

- A. Principal/HoD
- Postgraduate degree in Arts/Sciences/Social Sciences/Humanities/ Commerce with minimum 55% marks; and
 - M.Ed. with minimum 55% marks; and
 - Ph.D. in Education or in any pedagogic subject offered in the institution; and
 - Eight years of teaching experience in a secondary Teacher Education Institution.
- Desirable: Diploma/Degree in Educational Administration or Educational Leadership.
- B. Perspectives in Education or Foundation Courses
- Postgraduate degree in Social Sciences with minimum 55% marks; and
 - M.Ed. degree from a recognised university with minimum 55% marks.
- OR
- Postgraduate (MA) degree in Education with minimum 55% marks; and
 - B.Ed./B.El.Ed. degree with minimum 55% marks.
- C. Curriculum and Pedagogic Courses
- Postgraduate degree in Sciences/ Mathematics/ Social Sciences/ Languages with minimum 55% marks, and
 - M.Ed. degree with minimum 55% marks.

Desirable : PhD degree in Education with subject specialisations.






