## ACTIVITIES CONDUCTED BY THE COLLEGE ACADEMIC YEAR – 2020

The College of Teacher Education (PGT) is committed towards providing its student-teachers varied experiences through the conduct of various activities. Every year, various activities were conducted in the College by the Student Council and the various committees of the College. However, with the announcement of closure of educational institutions by the Ministry of Education, Govt. of India and also the Education Department, Government of Meghalaya, following the outbreak of the COVID-19 Pandemic, the College could not conduct the activities in a way they are held every year. It is rather encouraging to report that in spite of the National lockdown and in the midst of the Pandemic, the College has made an effort to conduct the activities through the various online platforms that maximum students can get access to. A brief report on the activities conducted/organised by the College is presented as follows:

1. **INTERNATIONAL WOMEN'S DAY** - The first activity conducted in the year 2020 was the observance of International Women's Day on March 11, 2020 at 9:30 a.m. The program began with a speech by the Principal of the College, Dr. (Mrs.) V. Kharmawphlang. The speech was followed by a song from the student-teachers of the 2nd Semester of the College. The program ended with a speech from a student-teacher of the 4th Semester, Miss. Aibatphida Nylla Lyngdoh who emphasized on the importance of the theme of International Women's Day, 2020 – *I am Generation Equality- Realizing Women's Rights, in this Day and Age*. The program was followed by an essay, sketching and poetry competition based on the theme, I Am Generation Equality, participated by the students-teachers of the 2nd Semester. This is the only activity which was organised offline.
2. **COLLEGE FOUNDATION DAY** – To mark the special occasion of the College Foundation Day on 19<sup>th</sup> March, every year the College organises a food fest and the money generated is being donated to the Reach Ministries an organization which funds for the education of street children. It is indeed unfortunate that the College could not organise a food fest due to the closure of educational institutions because of the COVID 19 Pandemic. However, to mark the auspicious occasion, on March 19, 2020, the Principal of the College, Dr. (Mrs.) V. Kharmawphlang greeted all the Governing Body members, faculty members, student-teachers, non-teaching staff and all well wishers of the College, through Instagram.
3. **EBSB Activity** – Amid the Lockdown, on 21<sup>st</sup> May 2020, the College through the participation of Second Semester Students created a motivating video entitled 'We shall Overcome' a Khasi version to spread awareness and help the citizens of the State to overcome the fear of COVID-19. The video was created as part of Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat (EBSB) initiative, Government of India. The video was shared in the official Instagram and Facebook account of the College.

4. **WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY** - The College through the active participation of the Student Council and the Environmental Education students was able to conduct the 'World Environment Day' on the 5th June 2020. On this day several activities such as poetry writing, power point presentation and a music video sung and composed by a group of students from the 4th semester and poster campaign were organised online. The music video and poster campaign were shared on Instagram, Facebook and YouTube.
5. **INTERNATIONAL DAY OF YOGA** - The College through the Student Council was able to celebrate the 'International Yoga Day' on the 21st June 2020 with the students performing various yoga postures from their respective homes. Video of the same was shared on YouTube Channel of Dr. B. Tron and in the official Instagram and Facebook account of the College.
6. **INTERNATIONAL DAY AGAINST DRUG ABUSE AND ILLICIT TRAFFICKING' AND 'VICTIMS OF TORTURE'** - The College was also able to observe the 'International Day Against Drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking' and 'Victims of Torture' on the 26th June 2020 via online contributions from the 4th and 2nd semester respectively. The video was shared on the Official Facebook page of the College.
7. **ONLINE LITERARY ACTIVITIES** – In the month of July 2020, the Literary Committee of the College invited student-teachers to participate in the literary activity on the theme **COVID-19 LOCKDOWN: REFLECTIONS**. The submission date of the various activities was August 3, 2020.
8. **WEBINAR ON ACCESS AND USAGE OF ONLINE E-RESOURCES** – On 23<sup>rd</sup> July 2020, the reconstituted IQAC of the College organised a One-day Webinar on 'Access and Usage of Online E-Resources' in collaboration with the Assam College Librarians' Association. The webinar was organised via the Zoom meeting platform.
9. **INDEPENDENCE DAY CELEBRATION** – The College celebrated the 74th Independence Day Celebration on 15<sup>th</sup> August 2020 in the College Campus where only the Principal of the College Dr. (Mrs.) V. Kharmawphlang, few faculty members and few students attended the celebration with all safety protocols being followed. Glimpses of the Celebration was shared in the official Instagram and Facebook account of the College.
10. **INTERNATIONAL LITERACY DAY** – On account of International Literacy Day i.e., September 8, 2020, the Principal of the College, Dr. (Mrs.) V. Kharmawphlang took the initiative of spreading awareness about Literacy being a fundamental Right among student-teachers and faculty members and urged every member of the institution pledge to continue to learn and to help others learn in every small way we can.
11. **WORLD SUICIDE PREVENTION DAY** – On September 10, 2020, the student council of the College organised an online programme to observe the World Suicide Prevention Day. An awareness talk was delivered by Mrs. P. Marak, Counsellor of the College. A video of the programme was shared in the official Facebook account of the College.

- 12. GANDHI JAYANTI CELEBRATION** – The College, through its Student Council celebrated Gandhi Jayanti on October 2, 2020. On this day, the students presented a short skit and a speech was delivered by Mrs. F. Marbaniang, Assistant Professor. To provide opportunity to all student-teachers to witness the celebration, a video of the celebration was shared in the official Facebook account of the College.
- 13. WORLD MENTAL HEALTH DAY** – To spread awareness on the importance of mental health especially during the COVID 19 Pandemic, the College join hand with the rest of the world to observe World Mental Health Day on October 10, 2020. To mark the day, a short video was created by Dr. B. Tron, Asst. Professor and shared with all student-teachers of the College. The video was shared in the Official Facebook page of the College.
- 14. ONLINE FRESHERS MEET** – The College, through its Student Council organised an Online Freshers Meet via Google meet on October 19, 2020. On this day, the Mr. and Miss Freshers 2020 were also chosen.
- 15. VIGILANCE AWARENESS WEEK (27th Oct – 2nd Nov 2020)** – In line with the NCTE notification on observe of the Vigilance Awareness week, the EBSB Club of the college organized a Webinar on November 2, 2020 with the theme – Vigilant India, Prosperous India. The Speaker for the occasion was Shri. Jacob Shylla, Assistant Professor, Department of English, St. Anthony’s College, Shillong.
- 16. NATIONAL EDUCATION DAY** – The Student Council of the College organised a Webinar on November 11, 2020 to observe the National Education Day, 2020. The theme of the webinar was on the National Educational Policy 2020 and the resource person was Dr. Batskhem Myrboh, Assistant Professor, Synod College Shillong.
- 17. ADVANCED CHRISTMAS CELEBRATION** – To wrap up the activities of the year 2020, the College through its Student Council organised the Advanced Christmas Celebration on December 22, 2020 in the College Multi-purpose Hall with strict adherence to the prescribed SOPs. Due to the COVID-19 safety protocols only the Principal, few teachers, members of the Student Council and selected students from the first semester were in attendance.
